Policy statement

Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- The village hall management committee display no-smoking signs.
- We actively encourage no-smoking by having information for parents and staff about where to get help to stop smoking if they are seeking this information.
- Staff who smoke do not do so during working hours.
- Staff who smoke make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues.
