REQUESTS AND REMINDERS...

TOYS FROM HOME...

It has been noticed that many children are currently bringing toys from home into preschool on a regular basis. Please could we ask you to discourage this as much as possible, the toys brought in are put to one side and not played with during the session in case they get broken, spoiled or put away with our toys.

Comforters for our smaller children, or something special to show at carpet time is fine, but please, no more toys from home. Many thanks for your cooperation...

SUN CREAM...

During the warmer weather, please could parents ensure that sun cream is applied to children at the start of the day. Staff will apply sun cream to children who attend all day on Mondays. Sun cream, as well as any other creams or medicines, should not be left in bags in case children get their hands on it. If you need to leave sun cream at preschool please hand a named bottle to staff at the start of the day. Thank you...

ILLNESS...

Remember that if your child is ill, or absent for any reason, please contact preschool by text or phonecall so we can keep our registers updated. If your child is poorly with sickness or diarrhoea they should stay off preschool for 48 hours from the last episode. Please speak to staff if you are unsure.
